Special Collection “Outstanding New Investigators in Environmental Engineering”



Overview

The Special Collection “Outstanding New Investigators in Environmental Engineering” of the ASCE Journal of Environmental Engineering will provide a standing platform for featuring the best work by researchers early in their professional careers (typically University faculty in the rank of Assistant Professor or an equivalent position for researchers affiliated with entities other than higher education institutions) working in Environmental Engineering and related fields.

The types of papers suitable for publication in the Special Collection will include “Technical Paper”, “Case Study” and “State-of-the-Art Review”. There are no thematic constraints on the papers in this Special Collection other than that the subject matter should fall within the Journal’s scope as described at <https://ascelibrary.org/journal/joedu>. When soliciting articles, the Editors may or may not ask for a paper on a specific topic; the choice may be left to the discretion of the author.

Invitations to contribute will be extended based on nominations from the broader community. Please submit your nomination together with a brief rationale by email to Prof. Dionysiou (dionysios.d.dionysiou@uc.edu) or Prof. Tarabara (tarabara@msu.edu).

The Special Collection is an ongoing effort (i.e. a standing Collection), with no end date. Individual papers will appear in print, spread over many different issues. However, each article will be marked as a part of the “Outstanding New Investigators in Environmental Engineering” Special Collection and all such articles will be assembled online on a dedicated webpage linked to from <https://ascelibrary.org/page/joedu/specialcollections>.
